#### INFORMATION & LEGAL ISSUES

*A vast majority of road traffic accidents happen whilst vehicles are reversing. There has been overwhelming evidence to prove this fact over the past few years. The main industries where it has been necessary to take action to combat this increasing problem has been the quarry and mining industry, on dump trucks and loading shovels, and local authorities, on their refuse collection vehicles.*

*It has now become legislation that any new vehicle going into these environments has to have a device fitted to give visibility at the rear of a vehicle. The most cost effective system to meet this criteria is to install a mobile CCTV system. Once a camera has been fitted to a vehicle, reports have shown that there has been an overwhelming reduction in accidents.*
